



Fly Tying Classes



The Raymond Recreation Department sponsors a fly tying group, The Liars and Tiers, every Thursday night at Raymond High School*, Room 226 (Art Room). Classes run from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM and cost \$3.00 each. All materials for the pattern of the evening, except for thread, are provided. Participants should have their own vise and tools. If you are new to fly tying and don't have tools yet or if you want to give it a try to see if you like it, there are group tools that you can borrow. A full-color recipe sheet giving details and step-by-step pictures on how to tie the fly are provided. The class instructors, Tom Jutras, George Hammond and Al Bovyn, have over 100 years of combined fly tying experience.

There is no multi-week course structure to the classes. Each one is a stand-alone class. An e-mail is sent out prior to the class announcing the pattern to be tied with a copy of the recipe sheet in case you can't make the class. Attend the ones you want or come every week.

During the year, we will tie dry flies, wet flies, streamer flies, nymphs, Salmon flies and even some salt water patterns.
